THE JSTP PROGRAM

Tidewater Community College's Job Skills Training Program (JSTP) is one of the most successful workforce development programs in the nation. We were awarded the Virginia Community College System Workforce Development Award for Program Excellence and the Program of Distinction award by the National Alliance of Community and Technical Colleges.

Since 1997, more than 1,000 students have been enrolled and 93% have been placed in employment. Employment is secured before any training begins. All positions are full-time with benefits and pay exceeding \$20,000 annually.

With the help of businesses, industry leaders, and social and community service agencies, the Job Skills Training Program has developed training for healthcare, banking & call centers, manufacturing, construction, and culinary arts industries.

The three-month training programs include: computer skills, business math, workplace values and attitudes, conflict resolution, team building, communication skills, and Moral Reconciliation Therapy (MRT®). Employers assist with curriculum development.

Upon graduation from the Job Skills Training Program the students have taken responsibility and gained insight for their life choices. This holistic and comprehensive program empowers clients to confront their barriers to success and achieve self-sufficiency.
